# Introducing 21 Days of Prayer

## Revival of God's People Leads to Spiritual Harvest

During the 40 days between Jesus' resurrection and His return to heaven, He gave one final command to His disciples:

*“Go therefore and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all things that I have commanded you; and lo, I am with you always, even to the end of the age”* (Matt. 28:19-20).

Jesus entrusted the future of His kingdom to His followers. When His followers are right with Him, obedient to His command, and filled with the power of the Holy Spirit of Christ, they will be used of God to multiply disciples among all nations (people groups).

*“God was in Christ reconciling the world to Himself... and has committed to us the word of reconciliation. Now then, we are ambassadors for Christ, as though God were pleading through us: we implore you on Christ's behalf, be reconciled to God”* (2 Cor. 5:19-20).

Christ's followers have been given the ministry and message of reconciliation. They are Christ's ambassadors. If His ambassadors are to fulfill their mission, they must live, think, act, and talk like Him. When people repent of their sin and come to faith in Christ, they are changed as their old sinful life is replaced with a Christlike life. God begins His work of transforming them into the image of Christ and they have the mind of Christ (1 Cor. 2:16). When large numbers or high percentages of a population are transformed, we call it a great awakening, a great spiritual awakening. THAT is what we need in America today, and that is why we are praying for God to do His work in us and through us.

During these 21 days, we daily will pray for God's people and His churches to be revived; so they will be the salt and light Jesus intends them to be (Matt. 5:13-16). When God's spiritual light shines into the darkness of an evil world, it dispels darkness as lives are changed. We will also pray to have God's heart of compassion for the lost world around us. As we become the instruments that demonstrate God's love,

and as we share the message of the gospel (the good news about Jesus' provision of salvation) with those who need to be saved, God will draw people to faith in His Son (John 6:44, 65). Each day we will pray in four major categories:

**I. Personal and Individual Transformation in Christlikeness**

**II. Restoration of Health in Our Churches and Denominations**

**III. Tears of Compassion for the Broken and Hurting in Our Communities – Prayer Challenge**

**IV. Revival Report or National Issue/Concern**

**I. Praying for Personal and Individual Transformation in Christlikeness**

We will begin our daily prayer with a focus on what God wants to do among His people who have departed from Him and His guidelines for spiritually healthy and abundant living. Revival is what God does to restore life and vitality to those who have a saving relationship with Him. When we came to faith in Christ, God placed the Holy Spirit of Christ in us and began the process of transforming us into the image of Christ. When we have departed from Him, He calls us to return to Him and His standards for a healthy and vibrant life. As you pray, *ask God what He wants you to do to demonstrate your repentance as you return to Him*. Each day we will give you a topic to talk to God about for yourself and other Christians you know. When God speaks and reveals what He wants you to do in response to Him, obey Him. Here's the full list of topics:

***Pray that God will enable you and other followers of Christ to...***

1. Return to a first love for Christ.
2. Remove every idol of the heart.
3. Pray for and seek first the kingdom rule of God.
4. Surrender to Christ alone as Master and Lord.
5. Confess and repent of all known sin.
6. Put away any doubtful habit.
7. Confess Christ publicly through bold witness.
8. Obey the Holy Spirit promptly.
9. Reconcile broken relationships.
10. Return to holy and pure thinking and living.
11. Demonstrate Christlike love and compassion.
12. Demonstrate Christlike mercy and forgiveness.

13. Demonstrate Christlike humility.
14. Demonstrate Christlike acceptance.
15. Serve others with divine purpose.
16. Steward well God-given resources.
17. Abide in an intimate relationship with Christ.
18. Pursue a renewed mind through Holy Spirit transformation.
19. Use time wisely.
20. Work with honesty and integrity to make the Gospel of Christ appealing to others.
21. Remove every spiritual blemish that distorts the image of Christ.

## **II. Praying for Restoration of Health in Our Churches and Denominations**

When God's people get right with God and His Word, churches and denominations will be restored to spiritual health as well. We need to pray for our leaders to lead us out of their own revived hearts and lives. As God establishes righteousness among His leaders, they are enabled to guide their people to follow the Lord as well. If we are to see our communities and nation transformed, Christ's churches need to function as He intends so that even the gates of hell will not prevail against them (Matt. 16:18). Here are our daily topics:

### ***Pray that churches and denominations will...***

1. Pursue a wholehearted love for Christ.
2. Help members make sure they are "in the faith."
3. Become and remain a people of prayer for the nations.
4. Restore Jesus Christ as Head of His church and Ruler of His kingdom.
5. Seek to align faith and practice with the plumb line of God's Word.
6. Publicly confess and repent of corporate sin that defames the name of Christ.
7. Demonstrate love for the lost world by meeting needs and sharing Christ.
8. Call out and commission those who are sensing God's call to vocational ministry or missions.
9. Forgive one another and reconcile relationships.
10. Bear one another's burdens and fulfill the love of Christ.
11. Love one another in tangible ways.

12. Humble themselves and put away corporate arrogance and a haughty spirit.
13. Restore and maintain the unity of the Spirit within the body.
14. Manifest God's oneness in relationships with those who are different.
15. Learn to function as a body of Christ where every member does his or her work.
16. Demonstrate wisdom and financial integrity in managing the resources entrusted by God.
17. Worship the Lord in spirit and truth.
18. Encourage one another and spur one another on to love and good deeds.
19. Demonstrate God's love by meeting needs of broken, hurting people.
20. Make faithful disciples who multiply through making disciples.
21. Do their God-assigned part of taking the gospel to the ends of the earth.

### **III. Praying for Tears of Compassion for the Broken and Hurting in Our Communities – Prayer Challenge**

Together we will pray for spiritual awakening in our communities. But that renewal comes as many people are rescued out of darkness and brought into the marvelous light through the saving grace of Jesus Christ. Bob Pierce (Founder of Samaritan's Purse) made a statement that has moved the heart of many Christians to pray the same thing. He prayed, ***“Let my heart be broken by the things that break the heart of God.”***

People who are especially needy, may be more open and responsive to the invitation of Christ to saving faith. We will pray for tears of heart-felt compassion for the broken and hurting people in our communities. Compassion is not just sympathy or feeling sorry for people. Compassion compels us to take action. When Jesus was moved with compassion, He did something about the needs He saw. As you pray, ***ask God what He would have you and your church do for these people to demonstrate the love and compassion of Christ and share about His saving grace.***

Keep in mind that even Christians may be experiencing some of this brokenness and woundedness. As they experience God's compassion and healing touch, they may have powerful testimonies to share with others with similar needs. ***Pray and take action for the restoration of Christians who face these circumstances.***

***Pray for people who are experiencing such things as:***

1. Spiritual death and bondage to sin without a saving relationship with Jesus Christ.
2. Loneliness and isolation.
3. Alcohol and drug addiction.
4. Mental illness.
5. Homelessness.
6. Physical and/or sexual abuse.
7. Sexual trafficking and exploitation.
8. Brokenness in family relationships.
9. Injustice.
10. Unemployment.
11. Addiction to pornography.
12. Severe discrimination or prejudice because of race or ethnicity.
13. Persistent hunger and malnutrition.
14. Grief over death of close friend or family member.
15. Victimization due to crime.
16. Unrelenting bullying by peers.
17. Imprisonment due to sinful act or behavior.
18. Suffering from illness or physical disabilities.
19. Plight of children who are orphans or placed in foster care.
20. Loss of home, business, or livelihood due to natural disaster.
21. Helplessness as immigrants with language and cultural challenges.

**IV. Spiritual Awakening in Cities and Our Nation  
Revival Report or National Issue/Concern**

***Pray for the light of the gospel to penetrate areas of spiritual darkness in your community and other cities and states throughout our nation.*** Demonstrate your faith by preparing for a spiritual harvest among the broken; the sin-sick; and spiritually, physically, mentally, and financially needy who will come to faith in Christ. Also, ***pray and prepare to make disciples of those who come to faith who are affluent, influential, and successful from a human perspective. Pray for and prepare to help all these to experience the power of the gospel to make them new creations in Christ where the old is gone and the new has come*** (see 2 Cor. 5:17). Keep in mind that these brand-new believers may be the boldest and most fruitful disciple-makers. Equip them to multiply the awakening to family, friends, coworkers, and those in their circles of influence.

In 1975 Loren Cunningham (founder of Youth With a Mission) and Bill Bright (founder of Campus Crusade for Christ) realized that to change society and to change a nation the gospel of Jesus must transform the people and penetrate the seven mountains or spheres of societal influence. As we pray for cities and our nation, consider the ways God wants to transform and use the people of influence in these seven mountains of societal influence. ***Ask God to guide your praying according to His will and work in the lives of people of influence.*** (For more insight on praying, see chapter 9 in *Making Jesus Lord* by Loren Cunningham with Janice Rogers.) Here are the seven mountains or spheres of societal influence that need to be penetrated by the lives of people transformed by the gospel of Christ and the work of the Holy Spirit.

1. Family
2. The Church (Religion)
3. Education
4. Media
5. Arts & Entertainment (including Sports)
6. Business (including Science & Technology)
7. Government

Our primary prayer targets are the people in cities, states, and these spheres of societal influence. In the following daily prayer guide we list for the focus of your praying toward the 42 largest cities in the United States and each of the 50 states. Our yearning is for a great awakening among the people in these and other places that will bring a spiritual reformation to our nation for our good and God's glory.

Daily, we will list one of the spheres of influence to guide the focus of your prayers. Don't let that limit you from praying about any or all the other spheres for a particular city or state. As you pray, ***ask the Lord to guide you specifically to pray for Christlike transformation in the lives of people in the various spheres of influence.*** Paul challenged Timothy and us to pray for all people for a divine purpose:

*"I exhort first of all that supplications, prayers, intercessions, and giving of thanks be made for all men, for kings and all who are in authority, that we may lead a quiet and peaceable life in all godliness and reverence. For this is good and acceptable in the sight of God our Savior, who desires all men to be saved and to come to the knowledge of the truth."*



## **Final Suggestions**

- As you are praying, you may want to write out a prayer response to God in the space on the page or in a separate journal. Record the things you sense the Lord is guiding you to do in response to Him. Record Scriptures God uses to guide your praying.
- Pray with others: your spouse, family, small group, church, or coworkers. Use conversational prayer where you pray about one topic at a time and take turns praying.
- Consider joining others in a prayer call nightly January 1-21 at 8:30 PM Eastern Standard Time. Hear from national leaders, hear reports of God's activity, and pray for revival and a great awakening in the nation.

# January 1

- Ask God what He would have you and your church do for these people to demonstrate the love and compassion of Christ and share about His saving grace.

## **IV. Spiritual Awakening in Cities and Our Nation Revival Report or National Issue/Concern**

- Pray for Christlike transformation in the lives of the people in one or more of the following cities and states: your own community, Washington (DC), Virginia Beach, Alabama, and Alaska.
- Ask the Lord to guide you specifically to pray for Christlike transformation in the lives of people in the **Family** sphere of influence.

# January 2

*“If your heart turns away so that you do not hear, and are drawn away, and worship other gods and serve them, I announce to you today that you shall surely perish; you shall not prolong your days in the land which you cross over the Jordan to go in and possess” (Deut. 30:17-18).*

*“Examine yourselves as to whether you are in the faith. Test yourselves. Do you not know yourselves, that Jesus Christ is in you? —unless indeed you are disqualified” (2 Cor. 13:5).*

## **III. Prayer Challenge: Tears of Compassion for the Broken and Hurting**

- Pray for people who are experiencing loneliness and isolation.
- Ask God what He would have you and your church do for these people to demonstrate the love and compassion of Christ and share about His saving grace.

## **IV. Spiritual Awakening in Cities and Our Nation**

### **Revival Report or National Issue/Concern**

- Pray for Christlike transformation in the lives of the people in one or more of the following cities and states: your own community, Tucson, Seattle, Arizona, and Arkansas.
- Ask the Lord to guide you specifically to pray for Christlike transformation in the lives of people in **The Church** sphere of influence.

# January 3

*“It is written, ‘My house is a house of prayer,’ but you have made it a ‘den of thieves’” (Luke 19:46)*

*“Seek first the kingdom of God and His righteousness, and all these things shall be added to you” (Matt. 6:33).*

## **I. Personal and Individual Transformation in Christlikeness**

- Pray that God will enable you and other followers of Christ to pray for and seek first the kingdom rule of God.

## **II. Restoration of Health in Our Churches and Denominations**

- Pray that churches and denominations will become and remain a people of prayer for the nations.

## **III. Prayer Challenge: Tears of Compassion for the Broken and Hurting**

- Pray for people who are experiencing alcohol and drug addiction.
- Ask God what He would have you and your church do for these people to demonstrate the love and compassion of Christ and share about His saving grace.

## **IV. Spiritual Awakening in Cities and Our Nation Revival Report or National Issue/Concern**

- Pray for Christlike transformation in the lives of the people in one or more of the following cities and states: your own community, San Jose, San Francisco, California, and Colorado.
- Ask the Lord to guide you specifically to pray for Christlike transformation in the lives of people in the **Education** sphere of influence.

# January 4

*“He is the head of the body, the church, who is the beginning, the firstborn from the dead, that in all things He may have the preeminence” (Col. 1:18).*

*“If anyone desires to come after Me, let him deny himself, and take up his cross daily, and follow Me” (Luke 9:23).*

*“If you love Me, keep My commandments” (John 14:15).*

- Pray for people who are experiencing mental illness.
- Ask God what He would have you and your church do for these people to demonstrate the love and compassion of Christ and share about His saving grace.

## **IV. Spiritual Awakening in Cities and Our Nation Revival Report or National Issue/Concern**

- Pray for Christlike transformation in the lives of the people in one or more of the following cities and states: your own community, San Diego, San Antonio, Connecticut, and Delaware.
- Ask the Lord to guide you specifically to pray for Christlike transformation in the lives of people in the **Media** sphere of influence.

# January 5

*“If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness” (1 Jn. 1:9)*

*“All Scripture is given by inspiration of God, and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness, that the man of God may be complete, thoroughly equipped for every good work” (2 Tim. 3:16-17).*

## **III. Prayer Challenge: Tears of Compassion for the Broken and Hurting**

- Pray for people who are experiencing homelessness.
- Ask God what He would have you and your church do for these people to demonstrate the love and compassion of Christ and share about His saving grace.

## **IV. Spiritual Awakening in Cities and Our Nation**

### **Revival Report or National Issue/Concern**

- Pray for Christlike transformation in the lives of the people in one or more of the following cities and states: your own community, Sacramento, Raleigh, Florida, and Georgia.
- Ask the Lord to guide you specifically to pray for Christlike transformation in the lives of people in the **Arts & Entertainment** (and Sports) sphere of influence.

# January 6

*Do you have faith? Have it to yourself before God. Happy is he who does not condemn himself in what he approves. But he who doubts is condemned if he eats, because he does not eat from faith; for whatever is not from faith is sin” (Rom. 14:22-23)*

## **I. Personal and Individual Transformation in Christlikeness**

- Pray that God will enable you and other followers of Christ to put away any doubtful habit. If you think something may be wrong, put it away.

## **II. Restoration of Health in Our Churches and Denominations**

- Pray that churches and denominations will publicly confess and repent of corporate sin that defames the name of Christ.

## **III. Prayer Challenge: Tears of Compassion for the Broken and Hurting**

- Pray for people who are experiencing physical and/or sexual abuse.
- Ask God what He would have you and your church do for these people to demonstrate the love and compassion of Christ and share about His saving grace.

## **IV. Spiritual Awakening in Cities and Our Nation Revival Report or National Issue/Concern**

- Pray for Christlike transformation in the lives of the people in one or more of the following cities and states: your own community, Portland, Phoenix, Hawaii, Idaho, and Illinois.
- Ask the Lord to guide you specifically to pray for Christlike transformation in the lives of people in in the **Business** (and Science and Technology) sphere of influence.

# January 7

*“Whoever confesses Me before men, him I will also confess before My Father who is in heaven. But whoever denies Me before men, him I will also deny before My Father who is in heaven” (Matt. 10:32-33).*

*“Now, Lord, look on their threats, and grant to Your servants that with all boldness they may speak Your word.... ## **IV. Spiritual Awakening in Cities and Our Nation Revival Report or National Issue/Concern**

- Pray for Christlike transformation in the lives of the people in one or more of the following cities and states: your own community, Philadelphia, Oklahoma City, Indiana, Iowa, and Kansas.
- Ask the Lord to guide you specifically to pray for Christlike transformation in the lives of people in the **Government** sphere of influence.



# January 8

- Ask God what He would have you and your church do for these people to demonstrate the love and compassion of Christ and share about His saving grace.

## **IV. Spiritual Awakening in Cities and Our Nation Revival Report or National Issue/Concern**

- Pray for Christlike transformation in the lives of the people in one or more of the following cities and states: your own community, New York City, Nashville, Kentucky, and Louisiana.
- Ask the Lord to guide you specifically to pray for Christlike transformation in the lives of people in the **Family** sphere of influence.

# January 9

*“If you bring your gift to the altar, and there remember that your brother has something against you, leave your gift there before the altar, and go your way. First be reconciled to your brother, and then come and offer your gift” (Matt. 5:23-24).*

- Ask the Lord to guide you specifically to pray for Christlike transformation in the lives of people in **The Church** sphere of influence.

# January 10

*“As obedient children, not conforming yourselves to the former lusts, as in your ignorance; but as He who called you is holy, you also be holy in all your conduct, because it is written, ‘Be holy, for I am holy’ ” (1 Pet. 1:14-16).*

*“Bear one another's burdens, and so fulfill the law of Christ” (Gal. 6:2).*

- Pray for people who are experiencing unemployment.
- Ask God what He would have you and your church do for these people to demonstrate the love and compassion of Christ and share about His saving grace.

## **IV. Spiritual Awakening in Cities and Our Nation**

### **Revival Report or National Issue/Concern**

- Pray for Christlike transformation in the lives of the people in one or more of the following cities and states: your own community, Memphis, Louisville, Massachusetts, and Michigan.
- Ask the Lord to guide you specifically to pray for Christlike transformation in the lives of people in the **Education** sphere of influence.

# January 11

*“As God’s chosen people, holy and dearly loved, clothe yourselves with compassion, kindness, humility, gentleness and patience”*  
(Col. 3:12, NIV).

*“A new commandment I give to you, that you love one another; as I have loved you, that you also love one another”* (John 13:34).

- Pray that God will enable you and other followers of Christ to demonstrate Christlike love and compassion.

- Pray for people who are experiencing addiction to pornography.
- Ask God what He would have you and your church do for these people to demonstrate the love and compassion of Christ and share about His saving grace.

## **IV. Spiritual Awakening in Cities and Our Nation Revival Report or National Issue/Concern**

- Pray for Christlike transformation in the lives of the people in one or more of the following cities and states: your own community, Los Angeles, Long Beach, Minnesota, and Mississippi.
- Ask the Lord to guide you specifically to pray for Christlike transformation in the lives of people in the **Media** sphere of influence.

# January 12
